NON PLANT FOOD INGREDIENT

Hydrate Granular is a unique proprietary blend of soil active surfactants on a granular carrier and formulated for monthly program applications in professional turf management and general purpose applications in lawn care and landscape ornamentals. Hydrate Granular performs best when initial application is made early in the growing season prior to environmental conditions that produce plant stress.

Hydrate Granular can be used all year round. Application timing and rates of Hydrate Granular may vary upon the time of year, soil type, thatch depth, and local environmental conditions.

Hydrate Granular should be applied using a conventional rotary spreader to dry turf only. Calibrate spreader prior to application. To ensure thorough distribution into the soil, irrigate at least one full irrigation cycle immediately after application and before mowing of treated area.

WATERING IN

Watering in is required immediately after application with at least one full irrigation cycle.
